Hedgehog class

Our key question is:

What is special about the Somerset Levels?

To help us answer our big question, we are learning all about the geographical features of the Somerset Levels and how people live there. In science, we will be describing and comparing different animals

In Badger class our focus text will be Tidy

In Hedgehog class our focus text will be What the Ladybird heard.

Fox class

Our key question is:

What is it like to live on the Somerset Levels, and how does the land shape people's lives?

To help us answer this, we will be learning about the physical and human geographical significance of our local area, with a focus on floodplains and rivers. In science, we will be learning about materials and states of matter.

Our focus text is The BFG

Religious Education-Understanding Christianity– God/People of God.

This half term, we will learn about a range of parables and how Christians put their beliefs into practice

Creative development

This half term, we will be focusing on sketching and painting landscapes, and children across the school will study a specific artist (KS1: Van Gogh, KS2: a local artist). In music, KS1 will be learning about pitch and beat through a range of songs

Otter Class

Our key question is:

How sustainably is it to live and work on the Somerset levels?

This term, we will be learning about the human and physical geographical features of the Somerset Levels and how we can ensure the land is used sustainably in the future. In science, we will be studying our local environment and describing the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect, and a bird.

Our focus text will be Darwin's Dragons

Physical Development

Otter Class will be swimming. In KS2, children will be learning how to play tag rugby, and Fox Class will be playing netball. In EYFS and KS1, children will be learning about the fundamental skills in PE. **Year R and Year 4 will have forest school.**
