Our key question is:

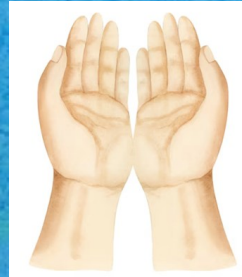
**How is the jungle different from where I live?**

We will learn how the Amazon Rainforest and Somerset differ by exploring their locations, climates, environments, animals, and the ways people live, while beginning to understand how maps help us compare these places. In science we will learn about the human body and how to stay healthy.

## Fox class

Our key question is:

**What are the similarities and differences of where I live and the amazon rainforest?**

We will learn how Somerset and the Amazon Rainforest are similar and different by exploring their size, location and appearance on maps, how Earth's systems create their climates, how people use and protect natural resources, how cultures and ways of living vary, what makes each environment unique, and how human activity is changing them over time. In science we will learn about plants and their life cycle.

**Our focus text is The Great Kapok Tree**

We will learn that Salvation is the Christian belief that Jesus came to rescue people and restore their relationship with God, exploring how Easter expresses forgiveness, hope, and how these beliefs guide the way Christians live and worship.

We will be focusing on using collage to create expressive and imaginative pictures. Children will explore a range of materials, practise cutting and layering skills, and learn how to combine colours, textures and shapes to communicate ideas.

## Otter Class

Our key question is:

**What makes the amazon rainforest an important biome and why is it unique to the world?**

We will learn what makes the Amazon Rainforest an important and unique biome by exploring its location, scale and structure, how its Earth systems create exceptional biodiversity, how people use and protect its resources, what Indigenous communities teach us about living sustainably, and how environmental changes affect its future and the world's climate. In science we will learn about materials and matter and reversible and irreversible changes.
